Defendants Chase and JPMC admit, acknowledge, and accept responsibility for the following conduct alleged in the Government's Complaint, as further set forth herein. Chase shall comply with all rules applicable to participants in the DEL Program and the Loan Guaranty Program, including the DEL Program requirement that it ensure the "integrity of the data supplied" to TOTAL. In connection with the data integrity requirement set forth in Paragraph 3 above, Chase shall implement an enhanced quality control program to review FHA loans that it underwrites using TOTAL. The components of such quality control program shall be negotiated in good faith among Chase, HUD and the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York ("SDNY"), and shall be set forth in a separate, signed, public agreement among Chase, HUD, and SDNY, as further set forth herein.
