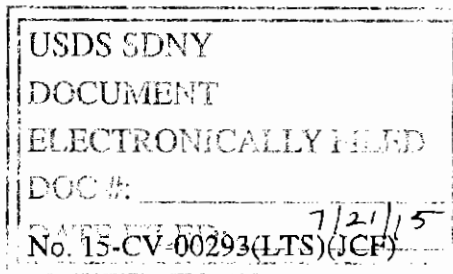

**ORDER EXTENDING TIME FOR
FILING OF A THIRD AMENDED
COMPLAINT AND TIME TO FILE
REPLY TO TRANSFER MOTION**

THIS MATTER being opened to the Court by Becker & Poliakoff, LLP, as counsel for the Plaintiffs, and being joined in by Defendants, for an Order,: (a) extending Plaintiffs' time to file a Third Amended Complaint and (b) extending Defendants' time to file a reply in further support of their motion to transfer venue to the United States Court for the District of Columbia;

WHEREAS, Defendants filed a motion to transfer venue to the United States District Court for the District of Columbia on May 22, 2015 (ECF Doc. No. 42); and

WHEREAS, by text order dated June 1, 2015, the Court granted Plaintiffs' letter motion extending Plaintiffs' time to answer the transfer motion to June 25, 2015 and extending Defendants' time to reply thereto to July 16, 2015. (ECF Doc. No. 49); and

WHEREAS, the law firm of Becker & Poliakoff, LLP entered a notice of appearance for Plaintiffs on June 5, 2015 (ECF Doc. Nos. 54, 55); and

WHEREAS, by Order dated June 17, 2015, (ECF Doc. No. 51-1) the Court granted Plaintiffs' letter motion extending Plaintiffs' time to answer the transfer motion to July 9, 2015 and Defendants' time to file a reply to July 30, 2015; and,

WHEREAS, by such Order, the Court also granted Plaintiffs until July 31, 2015 to file a Third Amended Complaint; and

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WHEREAS, there have been no other extension requests; and

WHEREAS, Defendants join in Plaintiffs' Motion and for good cause shown,

IT IS on this 21st day of July, 2015,

ORDERED as follows:


1. Plaintiffs shall file a Third Amended Complaint no later than August 24, 2015. Defendants will have 45 days to answer, reply or otherwise move with respect to the Third Amended Complaint. In the event the motion to transfer remains pending at the expiration of the 45 day period, Defendants shall file any motion to dismiss 14 days after a ruling on the transfer motion.

2. Defendants may file a reply in further support of their motion to transfer no later than September 4, 2015.

3. Neither party is permitted to seek discovery herein, or seek to enforce existing discovery demands, until the transfer motion is decided, except to the extent such discovery relates to the transfer motion or an emergency situation exists.

4. No further extensions.
